Colossus 2012 Excavation

The excavation undertaken on Colossus by CISMAS in 2012 was a great success. Thanks to all those who helped on this project. The project report is now available to download on the CiSMAS website.

Tresco Channel

CISMAS undertook a survey in Tresco Channel in 2011. The interim survey report is now available in the downloads section of the website. The final report will appear once John Allan has completed the pottery analysis. We are currently planning to return to Tresco Channel in the autumn of 2013 to undertake an exploratory excavation. This is to determine if there is any wreck associated with the medieval pottery recovered from the site (further details on the CISMAS web site). We are still waiting for final confirmation of funding from English Heritage for this project.

John R Park

We are planning to undertake a detailed side scan sonar survey of the John R Park, a liberty ship sunk in Mount's Bay in 1945 by U399. This will be followed by a dive on the wreck. This will take place spring or summer 2013. Anyone interested please email me and I will let you know once we have a firm date for this project.

Royal Anne Galley

CISMAS will undertake a survey as part of the ongoing environmental assessment of the wreck commisioned by English Heritage. This work was due to take place in autumn 2012 but unsettled weather caused the project to be postponed. Further details on the website.
